Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals: COVID-19 Focused Infection Control Surveys

Pursuant to guidance received from the federal government on March 4th, 2020 the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals (DIA) directed its attention on combating the spread of Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in Iowa health care facilities by completing focused Infection Control Surveys. Community NeuroRehab's (CNR) four facilities were surveyed on the following dates and each facility was found to be in substantial conformance in maintaining the health and safety of both participants and staff.
